

Micronesia

Located between Hawaii and Guam, Kosrae offers secluded beaches and cool highland forests. Home to the most pristine reefs in the world, this fabulous destination is for both novice and experienced divers. Known for invigorating drift dives and captivating soft corals, Palau hosts more than 1500 species of fish ranging from cuttlefish to napoleon wrasse. Yap's famous visitors are awe-inspiring manta rays, but the area also boasts lionfish, eagle rays and whitetip reef sharks. Truk Lagoon is an underwater museum of mostly upright and nearly intact World War II shipwrecks including loaded cargo freighters, aircraft and battleships. The island, now called Chuuk, offers a wealth of cultural tradition and historical sites.
