

# Philippines

Comprised of as many as 7,107 islands at low tide, and boasting more than 15,000 square miles/38,800 square kilometers of reef at the 60 foot/18 metre mark, the Philippines are vastly underrated as a dive destination. In business, customer satisfaction is often measured by repeat business. Official figures indicate that visiting divers usually average ten trips to the country. Stunning beaches, abounding water sports, golf courses and an active nightlife keep visitors busy topside, while diving opportunities are virtually endless and include walls, canyons, drop-offs, sandy cays, caves, coral gardens, wrecks, Spanish galleons and more. Fish are plentiful and include schooling jacks, barracuda, turtles, reef sharks and occasional manta rays as well as whale sharks.
